



Prayer is a powerful activity, that connects us with God. When we pray together in worship, we are "re-membering" the body of Christ – bringing it back together, and holding it by the ties that bind us together. Ties of love, of grace, of fellowship, of hope, and even of reformation. It's a bit like the stars peeking out at the height of the eclipse. Normally, they're hidden by the light – but that doesn't mean that the prayers aren't there, and aren't being seen.

So, when the eclipse comes, take a moment and marvel - maybe even pray and be thankful for the innumerable stars, uncountable prayers, and everlasting light that is God, who is always there, even when darkness – or light – hides God's presence from us.


